Rivers Preservation Portfolio

Investment Objective

The Rivers Preservation Portfolio targets sufficient returns to maintain the real value of the portfolio after inflation. The portfolio aims to achieve this objective by combining assets with lower volatility profiles although modest allocations to higher risk assets may be included if appropriate. The portfolio will be invested primarily in low risk assets which will be anchored to the prevailing risk-free rate of return.

Market Comment

Markets continued to recover during June after early-quarter volatility. Over the quarter market returns were modest masking losses following President Trump's "Liberation Day" on April 2nd and a strong recovery. The impact on lower risk assets was modest as Government Bond yield spikes proved temporary. Portfolio returns were boosted by increasing risk exposure on April 8th, resulting in a positive first half of 2025. During June the biggest contribution came from the modest Enhancer as investment grade debt added value for the month and the quarter. All Anchor allocations added value for both the month and the quarter. Diversifiers were more varied with negative performance during June reversing gains seen earlier in the quarter. Looking ahead, we plan to secure profits and reduce risk during July.

"Anchors": investments selected for low market correlation, low risk and capital preservation core characteristics. Significant allocation in low risk portfolios.


"Enhancers": selected to increase portfolio long term return but exposed to equity risk. Allocation likely to increase with risk tolerance as returns become more volatile.

Notes:
